Major Duties:

- Plan and execute the warehouse management procedures and policies
Inventory planning and consumption tracking
- Demand Generation and forecast to keep production running at all times
- Involve in moving inventory and materials across the facilities
- Responsible to develop the delivery plan and executing as per the production demand
- Prepare and process inventory for delivery, move materials from facilities to workstations, pick-up locations, or other locations.
- Sort, organize and store inventory in the proper location, Stack and organize large bulk items.
- Prepare and maintain a log of all the material, goods, package items and label them correctly.
- Maintain high standards in terms of quality and safety of products and storage environment.
- Escalate issues, report damaged or missing inventory to the Production manager.
- Move materials from facilities to workstations, pick-up locations, or other locations.
- Work as an active team member to complete team goals.
- Perform inventory stock takes monthly / quarterly and annually .
- Prepare and maintain all warehouse related documents and perform frequent assessments to ensure policy compliance.
- Factory asset management, record of tools, consumables
